Early Years declaration forms are completed each term. Children are automatically eligible for 15 hours of funding the term after they are 3 years old. If you wish to access 30 hours funding (15 hours more than the automatic 15hours) your application must be done online the previous term before you want the funding to start. <u>https://www.gov.uk/apply-30-hours-free-tax-free-childcare</u> There is criteria to meet. If eligible, you will be given a unique code, which must be re-confirmed online every 3 months from when you first applied. It is the parent's responsibility to make sure your child's funding status is kept up to date . We will need to know your child's unique code so that we can process your funding. Contact Jo Oak
