



## School Budget

As you will be well aware all schools are facing budgetary pressures and Elburton has not been exempt from this. The school has faced a large budget reduction this year due to Government cuts to funding. This includes £80 less per pupil. At the same time there are upward inflationary pressures on the school. This has led us to look closely at all aspects of the school budget to see where savings could be made. A decision was made to restructure the use of Teaching Assistants and in so doing voluntary redundancies were offered and taken up by some. Obviously we are sad to see any staff leave but we have prevented any compulsory redundancies. Despite the reduction in Teaching Assistants at the school, we are finalising a budget for 2017-2018 that is dependent on using unspent reserves and so hope for change in future funding to prevent future in-year deficits. We are adamant that difficult budgetary decisions will not jeopardise standards and the experiences of pupils at the school.
